- reference to the main variants and denominations of each tradition (where appropriate);
- ONE sample HSC question for either Judaism OR Christianity which covers the area of sexual ethics and
- ONE exemplar paragraph in response to your chosen question (a paragraph may consist of 6 to 8 lines).
